## Spotlight on: Your rights and responsibilities as a member

*In order to realise our vision of achieving a healthy, wealthy and culturally strong MG community, we promote a culture of professionalism, respect and integrity.* All members of MG Corporation are bound by the Rule Book and the Code of Conduct, which set out the rights and responsibilities of members.

### MEMBERS' RIGHTS

- **GENERAL MEETINGS:** Attend and speak at general meetings, put forward resolutions or ask directors to call a general meeting.
- **DAWANG COUNCIL:** Participate in the appointment and approval of your Dawang Council representative.
- **REPRESENTATION:** Nominate yourself or another member to be a director of MG Corporation or a Dawang Council Member.
- **INFORMATION:** Access the members' register, minutes of members' meetings and the Rule Book.

### MEMBERS' RESPONSIBILITIES

- **RESPECT:** Treat other members, elders, directors and staff with respect and dignity at all times.
- **CHILL:** Don't engage in personal attacks or abusive behaviour.
- **RULE BOOK:** Read and comply with the Rule Book.
- **BEHAVE:** Don't behave in a way that significantly interferes with the operation of MG Corporation.
- **CODE OF CONDUCT:** Read and comply with the Code of Conduct.
